

# Middletown Christian Schools 2020-2021 Warren County Career Center Partnership Program

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The Warren County Career Center has partnered with MCS to allow students to take classes at both campuses and still participate in MCS activities and graduate from MCS. Most students attend classes on both campuses and also take online classes to meet graduation requirements. The program requires good time management and online class-taking skills. Application for the 20-21 academic year at WCCC is in the spring of 2020.

## **PROGRAM DETAILS**

- This program is for students entering their Junior year.
- Students that are enrolled with WCCC and are required to be away from campus most of the school day, would be allowed to take online classes in order to meet MCS graduate requirements.
- Online classes would be taken at home. Would need a maximum of 2 classes/year.
- Must take Bible (Junior and Senior Year), Speech/Oral Interpretation, Computer.
- If students participate in this partnership program, they are permitted to be on MCS sports teams, be involved with afterschool activities, participate in drama productions, and graduate with a diploma from MCS.
