

# **Non-Prescription Medication Guidelines**

#### An important message from Nurse Jenna Combs

Parents must bring in any medications to the office. Students should not have any medications without permission in the school. Any over-the-counter medication that you want given in the school needs to be in the original packaging and/or sealed.

The Permit For Dispensing Non-Prescription Medications Form (found <a href="https://example.com/here">here</a>) needs to be filled out with instructions on exactly how you want your child to take the medication. For example, if the form instructs to give 200mg of ibuprofen, I will only give 200mg even if a parent/guardian calls and tells me to give 400mg. Also, the form needs to have the exact reason as to why the child can take the over-the-counter medication. For example, if you have for headaches on the form and the child's muscles hurt, I will not give your child the medication. I can only give the medication for headaches if that is what is indicated on the form.
