Suggested Core Course Progression:

Math - Algebra 1 → Geometry → Algebra 2 → Consumer Math / Honors Precalculus **OR**

Algebra 1 → Geometry → Algebra 2A → Algebra 2B **OR**

8th Grade Algebra 1 → Geometry → Algebra 2 → Consumer Math / Honors Precalculus

(Advance math track) 8th Grade Algebra 1 → Algebra 2 → Honors Precalculus →
Honors Calculus

English – English 9 → English 10 → English 11 → English 12

* Student may consider Honors English

(Prerequisite – B or higher in English the previous school year)

* To be eligible for Valedictorian/Salutatorian, English 11/12 honors must be taken

Science – Physical Science → Biology → Anatomy / Chemistry / Earth and Space Science →
Honors Physics

Social Studies – US History → World History → US Government / Economics →
Honors Ancient World History



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Ohio / MCS Graduation Requirements - **General Diploma** (20 Credits + Bible):

Math – 4 Credits (Required - Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2)

English Language Arts – 4 Credits

Health – ½ Credit

Physical Education – ½ Credit (2 Semesters) (Exempt if student participates in 2 years of school sports and fills out P.E. Waiver)

Science – 3 Credits (Required – 1 non biological and 1 biological)

Social Studies – 3 Credits (Required – US History, World History, Government, Economics)

Bible – Taken each semester student is enrolled

Electives – 5 Credits with 1 credit consisting of fine arts
(Required – Speech, Oral Interpretation, and Computer Applications)



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Honors Diploma - 21.5/22.5 Credits + Bible / 27 ACT Score or 1280 SAT Score /
3.5 or higher GPA (Meet 2 of the 3 requirements)

Math – 4 Credits (Required - Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2 OR equivalent classes)

English Language Arts – 4 Credits

Health – ½ Credit

Physical Education – ½ Credit (2 Semesters) (Exempt if student participates in 2 years of
school sports w/ a P.E. Waiver.)

Science – 4 Credits (Required – 1 non biological, 1 biological, and two higher level
courses)

Social Studies – 4 Credits (Required – US History, World History, Government,
Economics)

Bible – 4 Credits

Electives – 5 Credits with 1 credit consisting of fine arts
(Required – Speech, Oral Interpretation, Computer Applications, and 3
credits of one world language or 2 credits of 2 world languages.)
