We will kick off Homecoming at MCS tomorrow with a Homecoming banquet for our High School Students!


Students who have purchased tickets will be dismissed from school at 12 PM



FASFA Information

The 2024-25 FAFSA is now available for short periods of time while they monitor site performance during a soft launch. Here is the link to the FAFSA application for you to begin: https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa.

Remember you will need your <u>Federal Student Aid (FSA) ID</u>. The FSA ID (an account username and password) is a legal identity and is required to submit the FAFSA. Follow the link included to begin this process. It does take a few days for confirmation, so it is important to do this ahead of time before you begin filling out your FAFSA.

Here is additional information regarding the "soft launch" to the FAFSA application:

Soft Launch of the 2024–25 FAFSA® Form

The 2024–25 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) form is available periodically as part of our soft launch. During the soft launch, the FAFSA form will be available for short periods of time while we monitor site performance and form functionality. We will initiate pauses for site maintenance and to make technical updates as needed to provide you with a better experience.

You can complete the form to apply for financial aid to help pay for attendance at college between July 1, 2024, and June 30, 2025. You will have plenty of time to complete the FAFSA form. If you do submit your form during the soft launch, your information will be saved, and you won't need to resubmit your form or any related information. If your form is unavailable when you or your family members try to access it, please try again later.

What's New

The 2024–25 FAFSA form expands eligibility for federal student aid, including Pell Grants, and provides a streamlined user experience. 610,000 new students from low-income backgrounds will be eligible to receive Federal Pell Grants due to updates to student aid calculations. Plus, applicants will be able to skip as many as

26 questions, depending on their individual circumstances. Some applicants could answer as few as 18 questions, which could take less than 10 minutes.

Re-enrollment Information

Middletown Christian Schools is thankful for the opportunity to partner with your family in your child's education. It is our privilege to come alongside your family to teach and train your student in Christ.

MCS' re-enrollment period for the 2024-25 school year has officially begun. As previously communicated, all MCS families have signed and submitted a Continuous Enrollment Contract. This contract means that MCS will automatically re-enroll your student(s) unless our Admissions Office receives written notification of intent of non-return by January 19, 2024. The deadline to notify us of intent for non-return has been moved up due to limited space in classes and increases in enrollment. If our Admissions Office does not receive this written notification, your student(s) will automatically be re-enrolled for next school year and a fee of \$100 per student will be added to your FACTS payment in March. Tuition rates and the Per Student Assessment (PSA) fee will be available the first week in February.

Hello Parents!

The yearbook staff would love your help in gathering pictures of our students both at school events and even outside of school for the 2023-2024 yearbook. The yearbook company that we use has an app that allows you to upload pictures that will automatically upload to our program. The app is called Yearbook Snap and it is free to download. Here is how to download and use the app:

- Download Yearbook Snap on your device
- Search for Middletown Christian Schools (Franklin)

- Access code: eagles
- Once you enter the code you will be able to select photos (click the arrow)
- Select All Other Photos
- Select the photos from your device that you would like to upload
- You may have to go back and select All other Photos again to view the photos that you uploaded
- Select the photos you just added and select the bottom-right button
- Choose Continue
- Enter your name and email address and click Submit
- You will receive an email notifying you that your pictures were submitted
