## **FINANCIALS**

- Participating families are responsible to pay MCS Re-Enrollment and Curriculum/Activity Fees.
- Each MCS class is \$1,020 (this may be adjusted due to updated tuition costs).
- If a minimum of 3 MCS classes are taken, MCS would pay the WCCC program fee—up to \$400.00.
- If WCCC cost is above \$400.00, MCS will bill/invoice the family for the difference.
- MCS uses FACTS Tuition Management for families preferring monthly tuition payments. There is a yearly \$45.00 fee charged per FACTS contract.
- All school financial policies are applicable.
- Students enrolled in the scholarship program should discuss financial obligations with Mr. Mellish before enrolling in the program.

## **PROGRAM DETAILS**

- This program is for students entering their Junior and Senior years only.
- Due to scheduling conflicts between WCCC and MCS, student will be able to complete classes for graduation requirements through the online Ignitia platform.
- Online classes would be taken at home or during a scheduled MCS study hall. A student would need a maximum of 2 classes per year.
- A student is required to take Bible (Junior and Senior Year) and Speech/Oral Interpretation. If not already completed, students must also complete Computer Applications.
- If students participate in this partnership program, they are permitted to be on MCS sports teams, be involved with afterschool activities, participate in drama productions, and graduate with a diploma from MCS.
- The cosmetology program requires students to be at WCCC the entire day. The remaining required classes needed to graduate from MCS would be taken through the online Ignitia platform.
- Transportation to WCCC and MCS is the responsibility of the family or student.
