FOREIGN EXCHANGE STUDENT OPPORTUNITY

Attention MCS Families... Can You Help?

ICES (International Cultural Exchange Services) is currently seeking host families for 5 students eager to study at MCS during the 2025-26 school year. These students are excited about the opportunity to come to the U.S. and live with an American host family. Can you help make their dream a reality?

What's Involved:

- Students will pay their own school tuition.
- They come with monthly funds to cover all personal expenses, including school uniforms, school lunches, sports fees, entertainment, clothing, personal care items, and more.
- As a host family, your responsibility is to provide meals and a bed for the student. The student may share a room with a host sibling (who must be at least 13 years old and of the same gender). Each student should have their own bed.
- Most importantly, treat the student as a member of your family and make them feel at home.

Why Host with ICES?

- Enjoy monthly activities that you and your student can participate in together.
- You will have a dedicated local coordinator (Kim Shreve) who stays connected with both the student and host family, providing help and support every step of the way. She has been working with MCS families for over 17 years and in youth exchange for more than 22 years, maintaining a close working relationship with the school to ensure everything runs smoothly.

Benefits of Hosting:

- Cultural Exchange: You and your family will gain a deeper understanding of another culture while sharing your own traditions, making this a truly enriching experience.
- Building Lifelong Relationships: Hosting an exchange student opens doors to lasting friendships that can continue long after the exchange year.
- Personal Growth: Hosting gives your family the chance to develop new perspectives, build empathy, and become more globally minded.
- Support Every Step of the Way: Our local coordinator will ensure you receive full support throughout the year, from placement to any questions or challenges that may arise.
- Be a Missionary Right in Your Own Home: Hosting an exchange student is a wonderful opportunity to share your faith and culture, making a global impact right from your own home.
